

Creative Homework

For those of you new to our school, 'Creative Homework' is an exciting project that all our children are invited to join in with at three points throughout the school year. Each 'Creative Homework' revolves around a theme. Our third topic for this academic year is '**The Commonwealth**' in celebration of the commonwealth games being held in the UK this year.

The work can be presented in any form the pupil feels happy to work in. It might be dance, music, a piece of writing, storytelling, drama, art, a model, an animation, photography or some other form of I.C.T., sport or even a scientific or mathematical presentation (please name all work).



The theme is given to pupils before the half term holiday to give them some thinking time before they work on it during the holiday. This piece of homework, be it a presentation, demonstration or an item of work will need to be in school by the morning of Friday 6th June 2014, the children in each class will share their 'Creative Homework' with each other on this date. Teaching staff will nominate a representative from their class to participate in the whole school assembly to be held on the following Friday.

The following Friday 14th June there will be an extended whole school assembly to celebrate pieces of work that have been particularly outstanding in each year group. Parents of pupils nominated for this assembly, will be invited to attend.

A display of all work that is submitted will be held after school on Wednesday 18th June in the school Hall. Please come and have a look at what the children have produced.

Pupils are encouraged to participate in 'Creative Homework' particularly as it is an opportunity for pupils to demonstrate areas in which they have personal interests and strengths. It is however not obligatory.

Each pupil that participates in 'Creative Homework' will gain a stamp in their 'Creative Homework' passport. We have introduced a reward system for all pupils who show a commitment and participate in **Creative Homework**. We will be running free film screenings for every **three** Creative Home works completed with snacks provided to acknowledge all the time and effort these pupils put into their chosen presentations. The next screening is scheduled for Tuesday 8th July.
